## **Feast of St Oliver Plunkett Friday 1st July**

St Oliver was the last Catholic to die for his faith at Tyburn in England, and the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified in 1920. He was canonised by Pope St Paul VI on 12th October 1975 and is buried at Downside Abbey, England; his head is venerated in St Peter’s Church, Drogheda.

Glorious Martyr, Saint Oliver, who willingly gave your life for your faith, help us also to be strong in faith. May we be loyal like you to the See of Peter. By your intercession and example may all hatred and bitterness be banished from the hearts of Irish men and women. May the peace of Christ reign in our hearts, as it did in your heart, even at the moment of your death. Pray for us and Ireland. Amen
