## Ash Wednesday

Lent begins this Wednesday, 22nd February. We can use these few days before Ash Wednesday to get ready by thinking about what we will ‘do’ or ‘give up’ this Lent. We can share this with those at home and agree to encourage one another during Lent especially when we feel like giving up what we have decided to do. Let’s ask the Holy Spirit to help us persevere and always be prepared to begin again during our forty days of spiritual pilgrimage to Easter!

## Days of Fasting and Abstinence in Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from eating meat for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
