Eucharistic Adoration

It is hoped to begin a short period of Eucharistic Adoration in St Patrick’s Church, Legamaddy, at the shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Knock, every Tuesday beginning 5th December (the first Week of Advent). This will depend on the availability of a critical number of parishioners to commit themselves to one hour of Adoration each week; you may prefer to prayer-share this hour with a family member or friend. Next Sunday a rota will be available at Mass for anyone who would like to sign-up to one of the following hours: 12.30-1.30pm; 1.30-2.30pm; 2.30-3.30pm. Thank you for your support.

“Living faith and self-denial are expressed by making frequent visits to the Blessed Sacrament. There is no greater penance than to deny ourselves the pursuit of other activities so as to make time for Eucharistic Adoration. An abandoned tabernacle is a sign that there is a lack of living faith in the parish; consequently, we can be certain that there is also a lack of fruitful Holy Communion. The degree to which a tabernacle is abandoned is a sign of the degree to which a parish is in a state of spiritual ill-health.
