**Lay Funeral Ministry**

On Saturday 1st June, 17 lay people from six parishes in this part of Co Down successfully completed the Lay Funeral Ministry training program. Among them are four members from our Parish of Bright: Gertie Small, Deirdre McMordie, Mary Laird and Cyril Carr.

The Lay Funeral Ministers will be commissioned by Bishop Alan McGuckian on Sunday 16th June during the 11.30am Mass in Our Lady of the Assumption Church, Newcastle.

The main responsibilities of the lay Funeral Minister are as follows:

A lay minister may assist by

- Visiting the bereaved family
- Sharing information about the various funeral rites
- Assisting families with the selection of readings, prayers and hymns
- Leading prayer in the family home or funeral home prior to the removal of the remains
- Leading committal prayers at the graveside or crematorium
- Leading prayers at the time of interment of ashes

In the absence of a priest or deacon, the lay minister may lead a Funeral Service when Mass is not celebrated.

A Funeral Minister may assist in his or her own parish, or within neighbouring parishes as and when needed.

We wish the new Funeral Ministers every blessing in their Ministry in our Diocese of Down and Connor.
