Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine

Earlier this year a copy of the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was installed and blessed in St Joseph's Church, Killough. This is an authentic copy that was obtained at the Basilica in Mexico City where the original image is kept and venerated.

Of all the appearances of Our Lady down through the centuries it is the only time Our Lady appeared as a pregnant mother, carrying in her womb the Saviour of the World.

Saturday 31st May is the Feast of the Visitation of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth. In that wonderful encounter between these two mothers, Elizabeth told Mary, "as soon as your greeting reached my ears the child in my womb leapt for joy!" Their two unborn babies, Jesus and John the Baptist, greeted each other in their mothers' wombs!

On this special day, a blue sanctuary lamp beside the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe will be lit for the first time, and thereafter will burn day and night; a candelabra will also be available to light candles.

May all expectant mothers turn with confidence to Our Lady of Guadalupe for her maternal help. And may any woman experiencing a crisis pregnancy receive courage and strength from Our Lady to choose life for her unborn baby.
